## COVID SYMPTOMS

Thank you to all of you for keeping your child/ren off school if they display Covid symptoms.

Visit

[www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test](https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test) to book a test online.

You should book a Covid-19 test if your child has:

- A high temperature
- A new continuous cough
- A loss or change to their sense of taste or smell

If you are using the NHS track and trace App and you are visiting school, we have a QR code for you to scan. You will find it on the screen in the front entrance.

We hope that everybody remains well over the Christmas break. However, if there are any positive cases in the first week of the holidays we will need to track and trace all recent contacts in order that they can isolate.

If your child tests positive for COVID anytime up to the 23rd December please notify us immediately on the email:
