The Premises Officer is a key member of staff, who has a vital role to play in the management of a safe and secure learning environment. The Premises Officer works closely with the Headteacher and School Business Manager to prioritise, plan and schedule maintenance to ensure the school site is safe and welcoming.

We are looking for someone who:

- · is passionate about maintaining and developing our site
- recognises and understands the importance of safeguarding our children
- possesses a range of basic DIY skills
- is able to use a computer in order to maintain computerised records, manage emails etc
- has excellent interpersonal skills
- is able to work in an organised and methodical manner

The role requires work both inside and outside. Due to the nature of the work, a good level of physical fitness is also required. The job involves some manual handling and work at height. This role would suit a range of different applicants from school leavers to anyone looking for a new opportunity.

- · Organising and carrying out minor improvement works and decoration, eg, putting up shelves
- Liaising with contractors
- Conducting water testing




