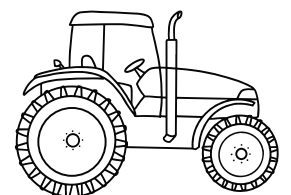

FOODBANK SUPPORT

Families in need can access our foodbank provision by contacting us in advance for a single-use voucher code. Requests can be made via email at support@horsham-matters.org.uk or by calling 0300 124 0204. We are able to provide food parcels on a fortnightly basis for as long as support is needed.

CONNECTING CAFES

We run weekly Connecting Cafés at the following locations:

- St Andrew's Cornerstone Methodist Church, Roffey
- The Sports Pavilion, Pulborough

Our cafés are open to all and offer a budget-friendly meal and a drink for £3.50, as well as kids lunch boxes during the summer for just £1.80 to help make lunch more affordable for families. We can also offer a free meal for those in need of foodbank support.

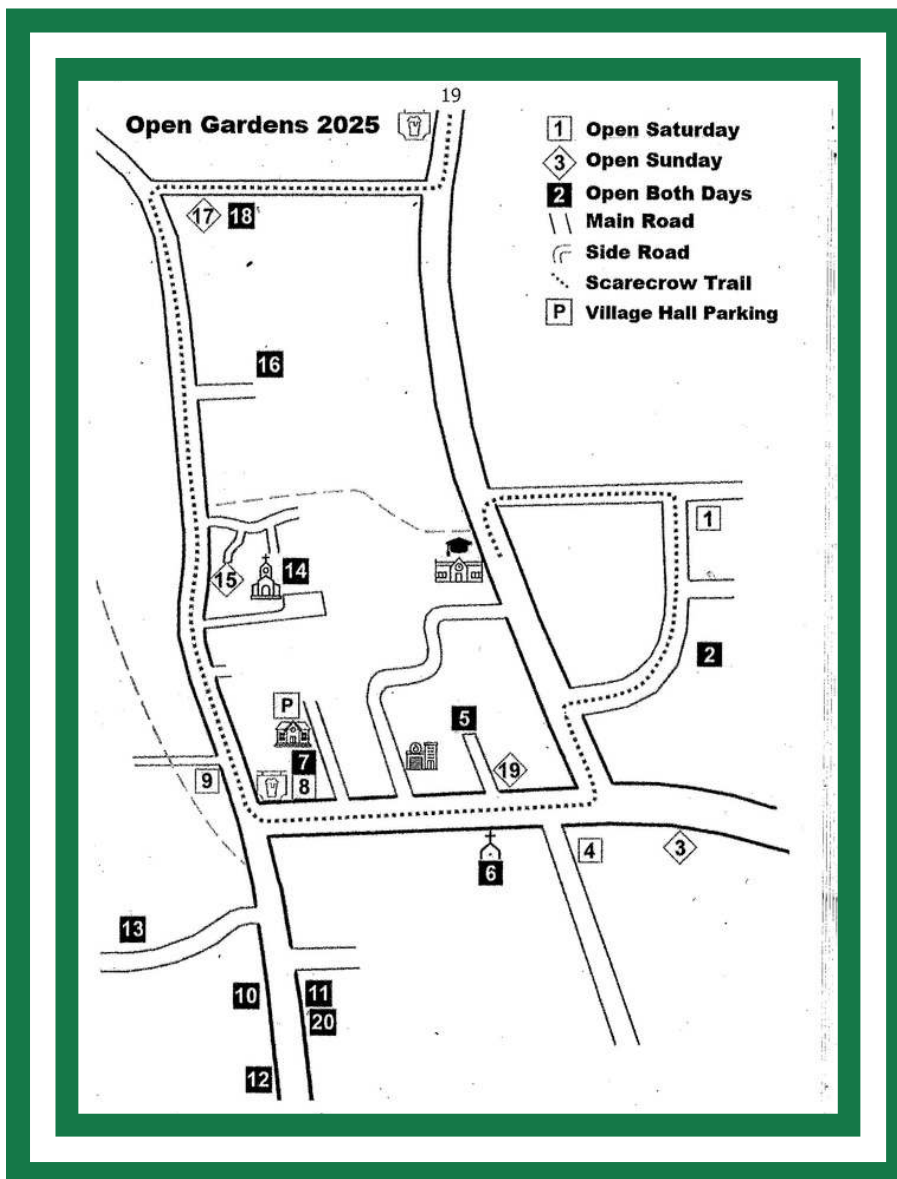
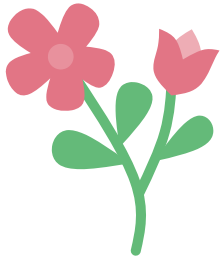
TOY LIBRARY

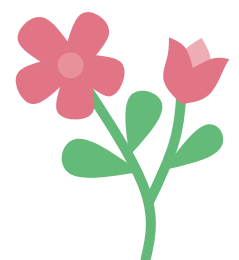
